1. **Wiley Carew McSwain** son of George B McSwain and Harriet L Padgett^[1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6] was born on 03 Jul 1877 in Ethel, Arkansas, Arkansas^[2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8]. He died on 22 Jan 1949 in Pulaski County, Arkansas^[7, 9].

Notes for Wiley Carew McSwain:

General Notes:

Wiley Carew always went by the name Carew.

He had been sick some time before he died. An autopsy discovered cancer and it is presumed that was the cause of death.

In the 1900 Arkansas County, Arkansas, census, Wiley's parents have died and he is head of the household, with his sister Callie and brothers Matthew and James living with him. His father George B died only two months before the 1900 census.

A Russell McSwain, age 21, is a boarder in the household of John and Julia Cook 4 houses down from Wiley and his siblings. It is not clear where this Russell came from or how he is kin to them. Like the others he was born in Arkansas, and both his parents were born in North Carolina. I have information on this Russell and his family from later records, also, but have been unable (as of September 2007) to find where they fit with the rest of the McSwains in North Carolina or Arkansas. This Russell is listed in later censuses as Russell a McSwain, and had a son named Russell also.

In 1910, Wiley Carew is married to Susie Lowery. The L in here entry Susie L appears to stand for her maiden name, since we know her middle name was Frances. Carew's brother Matt is still living with the family. Both he and Carew are working in farm labor for other farms.

Wiley Carew's death was recorded in Pulaski County, Arkansas. Death probably occurred in a hospital in the capital Little Rock.

Notes for Susan Frances Lowrey:

General Notes:

Different public and family sources have the name spelled differently. In her formal listing of family information, Bertie Lois Dumond McSwain spelled the name Lowrey. But in her letters and in spelling it orally in a family discussion, she spelled it Lowry.

In the Essex Funeral Home registry, there is a listing for a T W Lowrey (Book VI, 85). This is Susie's brother Tilley Wirt Lowrey. We find the family name spelled that way in Wirt's usage and that of his son, Tilley Wirt Lowrey, Jr.

Susie Frances Lowry's grandson Roger Louis McSwain, son of Louis Wirt McSwain, found that Susie's family name was spelled Lowrey on his father's birth certificate.

The L initial appears to be for her maiden name Lowry/Lowrey/Lowery. We know from family sources that her middle name was Frances. Note that the 1920 census is consistent with this as it reports her as Susie F.

Wiley Carew McSwain and Susan Frances Lowrey were married on 27 Nov 1902 in DeWitt, Arkansas, Arkansas, by Rev Cannon^[10]. They had 6 children.

2. **George B McSwain** son of George McSwain and Catherine Weathers^[14, 15, 16, 17, 18] was born on 20 Jun 1853 in Cleveland County, North Carolina^[17, 18, 19, 20, 21]. He died on 10 Apr 1900^[22].

Notes for George B McSwain:

General Notes:

The McSwains came to Arkansas from North Carolina about 1876. In 1870 Catherine and son Phillip's family are found in one household in Giles County, Tennessee. Other later residents of Prairie Township, Arkansas County, Arkansas, also lived in Giles County, such as the Butlers and Davidsons. George and his wife Harriet were born in No Carolina. Likewise all the brothers were born in North Carolina, and all their wives were except for William's wife, whom he married in Arkansas, and young unmarried James, still unmarried at age 21 in the 1880 census.

George and Harriett would have been in Arkansas no later than 1877, since their son Wiley was born in Arkansas, and is reported as 3 years old in June 1880. The family knows his birth date to be 3 July 1877, so they could have arrived sometime in 1877 before that time. Other factors with the families seem to indicate they arrived in Arkansas sometime in 1876.

William and his Arkansas-born wife Sarah had been married about 3 years at the 1880 census, since their daughter Edna Earl was 2 years old. This also indicates an arrival no later than early 1877.

3. **Harriet L Padgett** daughter of Wiley Padgett and Lavinia Nancy McSwain^[14, 17, 23, 24, 25] was born on 27 Dec 1855 in North Carolina^[19, 26]. She died on 05 Dec 1897^[27].

Notes for Harriet L Padgett:

General Notes:

The gravestone has only Harriet L McSwain. There is considerable circumstantial evidence from the Padgett and McSwain families that Harriet is the daughter of Wiley and Lavinia Padgett. David Holden has their daughter Harriet listed as Harriet L, as does the 1870 census, matching the name on the gravestone of Harriet McSwain. The age of Harriet L McSwain and Harriet L Padgett is within a year, though her date of birth on the gravestone varies from those by about two years, which we often find in census ages, but matches and the movement of the two families together from North Carolina to Arkansas, and the matching of names and ages for spouses of the two families.

George B McSwain and Harriet L Padgett were married about 1876 in Arkansas^[18, 28]. They had the following children:

General Notes:

Bertie Lois McSwain spelled the name of one sister of Wiley Carew McSwain as "Kelly" in a letter to her daughter Edith and son-in-law Orville Jenkins in 1977, giving some family information. She also pronounced it that way in a conversation with them in 1980, in which she provided extensive family information orally.

But her daughter Edith says she always heard it pronounced by her father's family as Callie. This is the spelling she remembers. Bertie's sons George and Frank also reported they had only heard Bertie pronounce the name as Callie. (There is only a slight difference in the vowel of the two names.)

Middle initial and birth date from Bobby Butler research.

Two censuses, however, have different middle initials.

In 1880 she is reported as Callie with no middle initial

In 1900 she is reported as Callie D

In 1910 she is reported as Callie L

In 1920 she is reported as Callie B

Her gravestone has no middle initial or name.

In 1880, she is listed only as Infant McSwain. She is listed as 1 year old, for a census date of 1 June 1880. But the birth date known by the family is December 1879, so Callie would not have actually been one until December. She was only 6 months old at this census.

Middle initial and birth date originally from Bobby Butler research. He appears as Matthew

O in the 1900 census, living with brother Wiley Carew, sister Callie and brother James. He appears again in 1910 and 1920, again in Wiley Carew's household. James appears to be James M (Jim, James Magnus), who did not appear in Arkansas County in the 1910 census, but is recorded with his family in subsequent censuses till his death in 1944.

The initial O could be for the name Oliver, which recurs in the McSwain family.

- iv. **James Magnus McSwain**^[14, 41, 42, 43, 44, 45, 46] was born on 01 Jan 1885 in Arkansas^[41, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48]. He died on 15 Oct 1941 in Arkansas County, Arkansas^[49, 50].

Notes for James Magnus McSwain:

General Notes:

The 1900 census gives the name James A as a brother of Wiley, Callie and Matthew O. James A is reported to be 15 years old, which would mean a birth year of about 1885, matching the birth year of James Magnus), born 1 January 1885.

James (A) McSwain appears as the brother of Wiley Carew, listed here as Carew Wiley. Carew is the head of the household after both their parents have passed away. Their father George died in April before this June census.

In the 1910 Census, Arkansas County, Arkansas, census, he is listed only as James McSwain. The 1920 census gives the name as James M. This is also the name on the gravestone in Mt Pleasant Cemetery, Ethel, Arkansas. I learned in January 2008 from public documents that had become available on Ancestry.com that his middle name was Magnus.

In 1910 James is married to Ruth Lowry and they have two daughters.

Stella lived only a few years. We find her grave in Mt Pleasant Cemetery in Ethel, Prairie Township, Arkansas County. Her date of death given there is 2 May 1914.

I see that in 1910, Ruth's birthplace is reported as Arkansas, but in 1920 it is Oklahoma. We know for mother information that she was born in Indian Territory, so the 1910 census is wrong. See Lowry family Notes.

Wirt B was born in 6 April 1919. This should make his age in February 1920 9 months. The enumerator must have had the right idea, but wrote it as though it was 8 years (instead of 8 months in the previous year) plus the one month of 1920.

James Magnus (Jim) was married to Ruth Lowery (spelled Lawery in some family documents and on her tombstone). Ruth died in 1924. Jim married widow Annie Padgett McSwain sometime between 1920 and 1930. Annie's first husband Robert McSwain died in January 1920, right after the 1920 census (in early January that year). In the 1930 census they are married and Annie's three younger daughters, Elsie, Nina and Hazel Bob, are living with them. There were no children from this marriage.

Bobby Butler research says middle initial is M. There was some uncertainty about the middle name; family members thought it might be Marvin, like his son. I could not get any information at that point from the direct family members to clarify this. In January 2008, I found James' WWI Draft Registration card online. This clarifies that his middle name was Magnus.

In 1930, we find that James' first wife has died, and he has married a widow. His new wife is Martha Annie Padgett McSwain, widow of Robert Perry McSwain, a son of Phillip K McSwain, one of the original McSwain pioneers. Robert is a cousin of James Magnus, whose father is George B McSwain. James and Mattie have merged their families into one large household.

The latter person is the son of Maggie E McSwain Rowland Porter, a daughter of Phillip McSwain, and thus a sister of Robert Perry.

Jim died by suicide. The date on his gravestone gives the date of death as 15 Oct 1944. It appears, however, that there was first a 1 (1941) then a 4 was carved over it. I first dismissed this as a prominent flaw in the gravestone, until I found the record in the Arkansas Death Index. The date of death on that register is 15 October 1941! Correlating with this is the report of his age at death at 56.

Generation 3

4. **George McSwain** son of William David McSwain and Judith A Moore^[51, 52, 53, 54] was born on 31 Oct 1798 in Rutherford County, North Carolina^[55, 56, 57, 58, 59]. He died before 1870 in Cleveland County, North Carolina^[60].

Notes for George McSwain:

General Notes:

Sources with full birth dates report the same birth date for George and his sister Judith McSwain. I find no comment in any of these sources, but assume this is accurate, meaning they were twins. One genealogy compilation I found only in February 2010 directly reports this:

"The Judith McSwain who married John Greene, was the daughter of William McSwain and Judith Moore. She was born October 31, 1798, and was a twin sister of George McSwain." This source also reports George's wife Catherine as Mary Catherine:

"George, married Mary Catherine Weathers."

George was hard to find historically, starting with the family in Arkansas and working back. Family memory had the first name of George, but the family had never made any tie to the North Carolina origins reported in the Arkansas census. I could not match him with any Georges I could find to match the age of his wife Catherine, who was a widow in the first record of the family in Arkansas.

As I gathered more information on more McSwain families, I finally found George, born in 1798. This told me why I had had such difficulty identifying him -- he was 21 years older than his wife. (In the 1850 census, the difference is reported as 23 years.)

I first found the McSwains in the 1880 Arkansas County, Arkansas, census. They moved there about 1875. They are found in Giles County, Tennessee for the 1870 census, as well as the Padgetts who are kin to them, and who move on to settle near them in the Ethel area of Prairie Township, Arkansas, near the White River. The father of the first family that settled in Arkansas, George, was not in the 1870 census, which indicates he had already passed away in North Carolina.

I began finding other McSwains from North Carolina in various places in Arkansas in 1880 and later, but have not been able to make any clear connection.

Most family genealogy compilations report North Carolina as George's birth state, as stated in this census and again in 1860. I found, though, that in the 1900 census, his daughter Nancy (married Henry J Turner in Arkansas County, Arkansas) reported her father was born in Virginia.

The name Ruske here appears later in Arkansas County, Arkansas, so this may be a kin of some kind.

We find the family again in Cleveland County, North Carolina, in the 1860 census, with other members of the extended family.

It appears George died between the 1860 and 1870 censuses. George is not with Catherine and the children in Tennessee in 1870. It appears they are on their way to Arkansas, along with the Padgetts. Philip is shown as head of the household and Catherine, with other children, are in his household, but there is no child Julius or JL.

It appears that Mary Weathers is Catherine's mother. From some genealogies, it appears Mary also had a daughter Mary. Some genealogies show George was married to both sisters. Mary died in 1835, according to some compilations. David Holden, who seems to have done careful work, and with whom I have corresponded on some of these families, reports that George was married first to Mary Weathers McSwain and that she died in January 1842.

"George McSwain was born Twin Oct 17 1798. He married Mary Weathers. She was born 1796, and died 21 Jan 1842. He married Catherine Weathers 8 Sep 1842. She was born ABT 1820 in North Carolina, and died AFT 1880."

David is apparently referencing family records, but sources are not clear to me.

Catherine Weathers and George McSwain married 8 Sep 1842. George was 43 years old when he married Catherine. One family genealogy reports Catherine as Mary Catherine. The first Mary was considerably older than Catherine, born in 1796.

One early source I found in One World Tree had an exact birth date for George, 01 Oct 1798. This is only about one year earlier than the common estimate of 1799 from the age at most censuses. However, this source and another also have some significant errors, duo mixing up this George with another George McSwain who moved to Polk County, Missouri. This source has a death date of

June 1834, which does not match our George.

Arkansas family memory indicated the father of the early settlers was named George, but it had been difficult finding a connection in North Carolina with a family that would match that pattern. I found them finally in the censuses of Cleveland County, a county with which I had not previously found McSwains associated. Cleveland was created out of the larger Rutherford County in 1841. There were hundreds of McSwains in the areas of Rutherford County or neighbouring South Carolina, Pendleton District, and some in Georgia.

It is not yet clear if there are any direct relationships to the McSwains in Georgia. There are some indirect connections to North Carolina McSwains, which I hope to pursue. Clear links with the branch moving into and through Kentucky are established in the Genealogy of Ran Raider, "My Maternal McSwain Ancestors."

There are also about three separate lines of McSwains in North and South Carolina who migrated directly to those areas from the Isle of Skye. Names vary in spelling: MacSween, McSwane, MacSwine and other forms. I have not yet been able to connect any of these separate McSwain lines in Skye.

5. **Catherine Weathers** daughter of Nofirstname Weathers and Mary Nola^{surname}_[61, 62, 63, 64, 65] was born in 1820 in North Carolina_[62, 66, 67]. She died between 1880-1900 in Arkansas County, Arkansas_[68].

Notes for Catherine Weathers:

General Notes:

Katy McSwain is a 60-year-old widow in the 1880 Arkansas County census. Neither Katy nor son James appear in censuses after 1880 (1890 data is not available, having been destroyed by fire).

It appears that all the brothers and Katy moved together. In the 1860 census Katy's husband George was 61 years old, 21 years older than Katy. George died before the family left North Carolina. He is missing from the 1870 census, when we find Katy and the family in Giles County, Tennessee. They are listed as Farmers, but apparently they were only migrants on their way to Arkansas, where we find them in the 1880 census.

In Giles County, the census lists Phillip (Phelp) age 21 as Head of the household, and Catherine age 52 is listed second. It appears her sons have come west without wives. The 1880 census shows that George, Phillip and Julius married women born in North Carolina. Family sources from North Carolina indicate that the three brothers married Padgett sisters, daughters of Wiley Padgett. Padgetts and McSwains had a long affinity in Cleveland County (before that part of the broader Rutherford County), North Carolina. These two lineages were jointly intermarried with Greens and Moores, with others like Bridges and Weathers.

Daughter Nancy McSwain is with them in Tennessee. By 1880 Nancy was married to Henry J Turner in the Ethel area of Arkansas County where they all moved about 1875. This 1870 census also gives

us Julius' middle name. Julius is listed in 1880 as J L and in 1860 as Julius L. Here we see no Julius but the age of the son named Login matches Julius. Login is probably a misspelling for Logan, since the latter name also appears later in the Arkansas McSwain family line.

William W, his wife and son Albert, died before the 1990 census. His other children do not reappear in this county, and have not been traced yet elsewhere. George died in 1900, preceded by Harriet in 1897. Phillip and family continued to live in Arkansas County. Phillip's sons and their families appear in the 1920 census.

Another brother of these men appears as Julius in the 1860 North Carolina census, and as J L in the 1880 census, in the house next to William, who lived next door to Katy. J L also is unreported in later censuses. No further details are known of him or wife Viney. Their son Samuel was buried in Ethel, Arkansas in March 1905, but his parents do not appear to be recorded in the 1900 census. Likewise his brother J W cannot be found again.

George McSwain and Catherine Weathers were married on 08 Sep 1842 in Cleveland County, North Carolina^[59, 69, 70]. They had the following children:

- i. **Polly G McSwain**^[71, 72] was born about 1843 in North Carolina^[73]. She died on Unknown.
- ii. **Sally H McSwain**^[74, 75] was born about 1845 in North Carolina^[74]. She died on Unknown.
- iii. **Phillip K McSwain**^[76, 77, 78, 79, 80] was born on 30 Jan 1847 in Arkansas^[81, 82]. He married Martha Elizabeth Padgett about 1875 in North Carolina^[83, 84]. He died on 25 Feb 1917 in Ethel, Arkansas, Arkansas^[85, 86].

Notes for Phillip K McSwain:

General Notes:

The starting point for understanding this family was the bare information of the 1880 census. There it appeared that Katy, living in a household with only her single son James, was the widowed mother of Phillip and George. They all lived in adjacent houses in Prairie Township of Arkansas County, Arkansas. Other likely brothers were William, who also appears in a house next door to Katy, and J L, next door to William, in the 1880 census.

They were confirmed as one family when I finally found the censuses reporting the family in 1850 and 1860 in Cleveland County, North Carolina. Their father George was in those censuses, but Katy appears alone in 1870 and 1880.

One of Phillip's sons was JE (Joseph Edward). Edith McSwain Jenkins reports that she remembers being told by her family that Joseph's father was a brother of George B, the grandfather of Edith's father Oliver. George B appears with the first McSwains in Arkansas County in the 1880 census, who all came from North Carolina.

Appearing only as P K McSwain in 1880 census, he is listed as Phillip in the 1900 census. The grave next to Martha in Mt Pleasant Cemetery identifies him as P. K. McSwain. The

one discrepancy is that the name of the wife of P K in 1880 is reported as Elizabeth. The wife of Phillip in 1900 is reported as Martha.

This is easily reconciled if we understand her name as Martha Elizabeth. The gravestone reads Martha E. She is also listed this way in the 1900 census [actually Marth E].

Ages are a close match, with the ages for Elizabeth and Martha giving the same year of birth: 1880 - age 32; 1900 - age 52. For Phillip, there is a discrepancy: 1880 - 21; 1900 - 53. We can commonly expect up to two years difference from census to census, depending on when a birthday is and at what date in the year the census is taken.

A Lavina [Lavinia] Padgett is reported living in this household, and she is described as his mother.

This Lavina Padgett is actually the mother of Edwin Padgett, who married Phillip's distant cousin Judith McSwain in North Carolina before moving to Ethel, Arkansas in late 1870. Their third child, Mary, was born in Ethel in 1871. How the enumerator confused Lavinia with Phillip's mother is a puzzle. This is one of the numerous errors in these censuses.

In 1900, there is also a Jane Padgett, reported as Phillip's sister. But there was no Jane in this McSwain family. An earlier transcription has been misleading because it had listed this Jane as Jane McSwain.

Multiple facts indicate that this Jane was Lavinia's daughter Jane Padgett. In the 1880 census, Jane Padgett was unmarried at age 26, and still in the household of her parents Wiley and Lavinia, who live next door to Phillip McSwain, and two doors from Phillip's mother Katy, with William McSwain next door to her.

Note that Harvey Criswell is living with them. Harvey later marries Phillip's niece, Callie McSwain, daughter of George and Harriet. Living next door to Phillip's family is Harvey's oldest brother, James Criswell, and his family.

It appears that several McSwain and Padgett families moved from the same area of North Carolina, through Tennessee and finally to Arkansas. This occurred over the period of about 1865-75. Edith McSwain Jenkins reports that she recalls it being said that the men came first, then sent for their families. The period of the move was fairly short, however. I have found that none of the McSwain men were married in 1870 in Tennessee.

We don't know exactly how long they were in Tennessee before moving on to Arkansas, but it was 10 years or less. We now know that Katy's husband George died in North Carolina between the 1860 and 1870 census. He is last seen in 1860.

In the 1870 census, Katy and her children are in a household headed by Phillip. Phillip (spelled Phelp) is a farmer. Catherine is listed second as Keeping House. We cannot tell how long the family have been in Tennessee before the 1870 census.

Phillip and all his siblings are single in the 1870 census. We find him and his mother and all the brothers except Francis in Giles County, Tennessee. Francis moved on to Arkansas earlier with a cousin, and settled in St Charles on the White River, in the northern section of Prairie Township in Arkansas County.

I learned the maiden name of Phillip's wife in November 2008. A McSwain researcher working on the family from the North Carolina side knew the name of Wiley Padgett's wife, Lavinia Nancy McSwain, a cousin of Phillip's father George. In reviewing the Padgett-McSwain connections with this new information, I realized I already had the names of the McSwain boys' wives but had not made the connection.

It turned out that three daughters of Wiley Padgett and Nancy McSwain Padgett were the wives of Phillip and two of his brothers. A son of Wiley and Lavinia Nancy's son Edwin also married a McSwain cousin, Judith, and they moved to the same area. Padgetts and McSwains were intermarried for several generations in North Carolina, and their relationships continued in Arkansas.

The McSwains and Padgetts lived in Cleveland County, North Carolina. Martha Padgett's family were in Buncombe County, North Carolina, for the 1860 census. In 1870 we see the Arkansas pioneers of both families on their way west. Then we find them in Cocke County, Tennessee for the 1870 census.

For the 1870 census, the McSwains were in Giles County, Tennessee. These counties are quite far apart, so there is no indication that they were in touch during the time in Tennessee. They moved either together or about the same time to Arkansas County, Arkansas, settling in Ethel, a community south of St Charles, on the White River in southern Prairie Township.

Philip's brother Julius Logan (J L) married Martha Padgett's sister Levina in about 1875. Their brother George B married another sister, Harriet Padgett, in 1876. That same year William McSwain married Sarah Lowe, a daughter of an Arkansas family, born in Arkansas. It seems likely that they all married in Arkansas. I would expect they moved in the early 1870s, since some or all of them were married by 1875 in Arkansas.

The Padgett family, including the three who later marry Katy McSwain's sons, are in Cocke County, Tennessee, for the 1870 census. Their post office is given as Newport, which is the county seat, though near the border with Jefferson County, Tennessee.

I find this interesting, since the McSwains and Padgett's are my wife Edith's family, and Cocke County is where all the children of my great-grandparents Dock Patrick Gregory and Julia Ann Clementine Strange Gregory were born before the family moved to Indian Territory about 1895.

In the 1880 census Wiley and Lavinia and their children are in Ethel, Arkansas, living next door to Phillip. Edwin and Judith are living in the same area a little farther away.

In 1900 Edwin's mother Lavinia (Lavina) and her daughter Jane are living with Phillip. In 1910 Jane is still single and living with Phillip's daughter Maggie Nolen and her family.

The 1870 census reports Phillip's age as 21, but the family has an exact birth date for him as 30 January 1847. This means he should have been 22 at his last birthday 6 months before the 1870 census.

The next thing we know, they are all married with children in the 1880 census in Prairie Township (Ethel), Arkansas County, Arkansas.

In 1900, a Lester McSwain, 1 year old, is reported in Phillip's household as a grandson. This is Cyrus Lester, a child of a daughter who was born after the 1880 census, and died in childbirth. We have no record of her name. A grandson of Cyrus Lester, Kevin McSwain, tells me Cyrus Lester's mother's name was Tissie (also spelled Tissey in some families of that era). I have other details about the family of Cyrus Lester in his Notes.

Cyrus Lester, who went by Lester, had a son named Cyrus Lester, Jr, who goes by C L. Kevin, who gave me information about the descendants of Lester, is the son of Cyrus Lester, Jr. In 1910 Lester is still reported in Phillip's household, as a grandson. Lester appears with his wife Mattie as a separate household in 1920.

I note that Lillie is listed before Ben, although the age of Lillie appears to be 22. This

matches the birth year we have for her in 1888. Normally the oldest child is listed first.

Kevin McSwain, Lester's grandson, tells us Lester's father was named John McSwain. He was a cousin of some sort to that family. I have not yet been able to trace the exact identity of this John. After Lester's mother died in childbirth, John moved on to Texas and established a family there, while Lester stayed with his grandfather.

There is a listing for P K McSwain of Arkansas County in the 1911 registry of Confederate Veterans in Arkansas. No personal information is available from this.

There is a grave for both Philip and his wife Martha E in Mt Pleasant Cemetery, Ethel, where most of the McSwains are buried. We also found graves for his children Robert and Bennie.

- iv. **Francis M McSwain**^[87, 88, 89] was born about 1849 in Cleveland County, North Carolina^[88, 89, 90]. He died on Unknown.

Notes for Francis M McSwain:

General Notes:

30 September 2007 -- I have now determined that Francis was the first of the family of North Carolina McSwains to settle in Arkansas County. I have found him in Prairie Township, in 1870, while his mother Katy (Catherine) and his other brothers and sister Nancy are in Giles County, Tennessee, for the 1870 census. (This is also where the Butler family lived before some of them also showed up in Prairie Township of Arkansas County.)

Francis is single and living alone in a separate household, but next door to John F and Mary G McSwain, both also born in North Carolina. They are shown with a Post Office of St. Charles, but both John and Francis are shown as farmers. They probably were living south of St Charles, the nearest post office. This is where the whole McSwaine clan later settle, near Ethel. Ethel later got its own post office. Both St Cahries and Ethel are in Prairie Township.

George and his family are still reported in or near St. Charles, still in Prairie Township, in 1880, when Katy, Francis and the whole family (less father George who died before they moved to Tennessee) are a bit farther south near Ethel, in the same Prairie Township or Arkansas County.

John and Mary moved to St Charles only a few months before the census in July of 1870. Their son John F is reported as born in Tennessee in October 1869. (Birth months of those less than one year old are included in this census.) So they had to move from Tennessee between October 1869 and July 1870. I expect that they were living near Katy and the family in Giles County, Tennessee, where John was born, then Francis moved with them to Arkansas, likely in the Spring of 1870, after the winter.

John F's son, George F, later moved to Texas, where other McSwains of the Carolina clan also move directly or from Arkansas.

I have not yet determined how John F McSwain is kin to these McSwains. But there are several indications that he is from the same clan in Cleveland County, North Carolina. I am also close to making connections to several other McSwain families from North Carolina who are in other Arkansas counties in 1870-80.

Julius L McSwain appears first in the 1860 census in Cleveland (formerly Rutherford) County, North Carolina, at the age of 8.

After the move of some members of the family to Arkansas County, Arkansas, about 1875, J L appears in only the 1880 Arkansas County, Arkansas, census. Two children are reported in that census: Samuel, age 4, who was buried in March 1905 in Mt Pleasant Cemetery in Ethel, Arkansas, and J W, about whom we have not yet learned anything further.

Viney is probably a nickname for Lavinia, a common name in that era, and in related families in North Carolina. Details on the families around indicate that Viney is Levina (Lavinia) Padgett, daughter of Wiley and Lavinia McSwain Padgett.

J W is possibly the J W McSwain born in Arkansas that I later find in Texas. This J W was John McSwain, who died in Gray County, Texas on 21 April 1927.

It is possible an entry in the Panola Mississippi census in 1920 (Beat 5, Page: 4A, Hse #7) is for our Julius L, but the age is older than we expect J L to be from our previous information:

He is there with his widowed mother and other brothers, except Francis, who has already moved on with some other McSwains from North Carolina to Ethel, Arkansas, where we will find William and his mother and brothers in 1880.

His gravestone has only the initials W W. In Mt Pleasant Cemetery, Ethel, Arkansas, there is one gravestone for three people, WW, Sarah and their son Albert. There is a range of dates, rather than discrete information on each person. The second date is faded. It seems to read "1895 to 1904."

The date 1895 must be the date Albert died, since William and Sarah's second son was born in 1896. Neither Sarah nor William show up in the 1900 census. Since the range of dates ends in 1904, at least one of the parents lived till then. It is likely that William died before the census, since his household is not reported in the census.

Jerry Gallagher provides information on this family. Researcher Paul Sarrett has information on earlier generations of McSwains in North Carolina, where William and his family came from. I reference them in some information.

Before making a connection with any McSwains in North Carolina, I had determined that William was a brother of the other two McSwains that show up for the first time in the 1880 Arkansas County census. Katy, a widow age 60, seemed to be the mother of three young

men who apparently moved with her to Arkansas. These were William, Phillip K, George and J L, later determined to be Julius L[jogan] reported in earlier North Carolina censuses.

When I found the Cleveland County, North Carolina, censuses of 1850 and 1860, this was confirmed. I also found later about the young brother Francis moving early to Arkansas. He is already in Prairie Township, Arkansas County, near Ethel, which becomes the new home of the McSwain clan.

A Judith N McSwain also moved to Arkansas, with her husband Edwin Padgett, to Ethel, and in later life to Ward in Lonoke County, over a hundred miles to the northwest. I suspected Judith's family were kin to this Arkansas family of McSwain pioneers, but could not confirm it till months later I had finally located Katy and her husband George quite some time later in the NC census. Judith was a second cousin of George and Catherine's children.

A grandson of Phillip named Lester was also reported in 1900, and I later made contact with Lester's grandson, who indicated that Lester's mother was a daughter of Philip who died in childbirth, of whom we have no clear record. (See discussion on Cyrus Lester and Phillip's daughter Maggie E.)

- ix. **James L McSwain**^[114, 115, 116] was born in 1859 in Cleveland County, North Carolina^[116, 117, 118]. He died on Unknown.

In 1870, James was with his mother and siblings in Giles County, Tennessee. His older brother Phillip (reported here as Phelp) is listed as head of household.

James appears among the first McSwains in Arkansas County in the 1880 census. He is apparently still unmarried, as the only two persons reported in that one household are James, age 21, and head of household Katy, age 60. Originally based on the 1880 census alone, I concluded that Katy is the mother of James. This was confirmed when I found earlier records of the family in North Carolina.

Phillip McSwain and family live nearby in house #105. This family group also includes George, living in house #52 in this census.

James does not appear in the 1900 census for Prairie Township or otherwise in Arkansas County.

Catherine's mother was named Mary, and she also had a sister named Mary. At least one source reports Catherine as Mary Catherine.

There were apparently no children from the marriage of George and Mary.

George McSwain and Mary Weathers married. They had no children.

In the 1900 census, Lavinia is living in the household of Phillip K McSwain in Ethel. They lived nearby in the 1880 census. A woman named Jane McSwain, age 52, is also living with him, but is called his sister. It initially seemed likely that the Jane was Wiley and Lavinia's daughter Jane, but there was some confusion due to the listing of Jane as Phillip's sister, and Lavinia as his mother. I knew from other information that Lavinia was not his mother. Piece by piece their relationship was clarified. The closest relationship I could find was that Lavinia was the mother-in-law of Judith N McSwain, a cousin of Phillip.

the final piece came in October 2007, when David Holden, researching the line from the North Carolina side, informed me that Phillip's wife was Lavinia's daughter. This clarified that the enumerator should have listed Lavinia as mother-in-law and Jane as sister-in-law.

This popular name of the 1800s is found spelled in various families of that era as Louvenia, Louvinia, Lavinia, Lovinia, etc.

Wiley and Lavinia live next door to P K McSwain in the 1880 census. In 1900 she is living in PK's household.

In their household is a boarder named Ida McSwain. But Ida's age is only 4! She was born in September 1895. The Padgetts are cousins to the McSwains in Arkansas County. I have not been able to account for Ida among the families I know. There are no other McSwains around them.

There were other McSwains from North Carolina in other counties of Arkansas at this time, and this Ida could be from one of them that I do not have information on.

I later found a Hamrick genealogy that adds a few other details, like Edwin's first initial W. This may stand for William, since that is such a prominent name among the Padgetts and related families.

General Notes:

We do not know Martha Elizabeth's last name. I have searched many records of McSwains in North Carolina. This family appeared to be related to other McSwains in Rutherford (Cleveland) County, but I cannot make a clear match to the many McSwain historical records and genealogies available.

It at first appeared from the birth states of members of this family and their spouses that Martha Elizabeth and Phillip were married just before moving to Arkansas. After finding Phillip and his siblings with their mother in Tennessee, this did not seem likely, because none of them had spouses in the household. Lavinia and Wiley were also in Tennessee in 1870, though in a different county. After finding members of the family in Prairie Township of Arkansas in 1870, it appeared that the Padgetts and McSwains got together in Arkansas. Phillip's cousin Judith had already married Martha Elizabeth's brother Edwin in North Carolina, and then they all wound up in Ethel, Arkansas.

Phillip and Elizabeth must have married right after the McSwains arrived in the Ethel area, or they married and moved together to Arkansas. Their first child was born about 1876, being reported as age 4 in the 1880 Arkansas County census. So there it seems to be about 1875-6 when the family moved from Tennessee to Arkansas.

Martha Elizabeth's age in the census is off from the date reported by her gravestone, which

has a date of birth of 27 October 184. In the August 1870 census Martha E Padget [sic] was reported as 20 years old. This would mean on her birthday in October that year she would have been 21, making a birth year of 1849. This is a 4-year difference, but not unheard of.

Phillip's brother William married an Arkansas-born woman, so it makes sense that he also married after the family arrived in Arkansas, probably about 1877, according to the age of their first child, age 2 in the 1880 census. This is consistent with the idea that the family all moved together.

In October 2007, I got an email from another McSwain researcher in Germany who provided the rest of the details to finish tying this family together. David Holden informed me that Lavinia Padgett's last name was also McSwain, and that Martha Elizabeth was her daughter. In the process I learned why I had been unable to make the connection before.

The parents of Lavinia Nancy McSwain are William McSwain and Mary Nancy Bridges. Other genealogies I had found up to this point had William's wife as Judith Hamrick. The dates of children and marriage to Judith make a full picture now to indicate that Judith was the second wife. The other genealogies also thus lacked the children of William with Mary Nancy. Lavinia was one of those.

This also better explains why Lavinia and her daughter Jane are living with Phillip and Martha Elizabeth after the death of Wiley. Martha is her daughter and thus Phillip's mother-in-law. This partly explains the puzzling entry in the 1900 census that Lavinia is Phillip's mother and Jane his sister, which led to lots of run-arounds and dead-ends!

- vi. **William A Padgett**^[137, 156] was born on 18 Nov 1845 in North Carolina^[137, 156]. He died on 21 Sep 1922 in Cleveland County, North Carolina^[137, 157].

Notes for William A Padgett:

General Notes:

The Hamrick Data pages reports this William A as the son of Edwin and Judith McSwain Padgett. But he is actually the brother of Edwin, son of Wiley and Lavinia Nancy Padgett. David Holden correctly reports William A in this connection. The dates and places in Holden's genealogy of the McSwain, Bridges and Padgetts fits the other known facts of the Padgett family tree.

William A Padgett was born in North Carolina and remained there when others of his family moved to Tennessee then Arkansas. The son of Edwin and Judith was William Ensley Padgett. He was also born in North Carolina, but was taken by his parents to Arkansas. W E is listed in Prairie Township of Arkansas County, Arkansas, with his family and some of his McSwain cousins in the 1880 census. He later moved to Yell County, Arkansas, and died there.

- vii. **Nancy Jane Padgett**^[158, 159, 160, 161, 162, 163] was born in Jan 1849 in North Carolina^[160, 162, 163, 164]. She died on Unknown.

Jane Padgett is at home with her parents Wiley and Lavinia, at reported age 26, in the 1880 Arkansas County, Arkansas, census. This would make an approximate birth year of 1854. But in the 1900 census her birth date is given as January 1849.

Jane is reported in Phillip's household only in the 1900 Arkansas County census, as a sister of Phillip. But she is Single, and her last name is Padgett.

It appears likely that this is Jane Padgett, daughter of Wiley and Lavinia Padgett. Lavinia is living with Phillip McSwain in 1990. In 1880 Wiley and Lavinia, with daughter Jane, were living next door to Phillip. Lavinia Padgett is also erroneously reported in the 1900 census as Phillip's mother. Lavinia is the mother-in-law of a cousin of Phillip, Judith N McSwain, daughter of Louis McSwain.

The identity of Jane seems clarified in the 1910 census, where Jane Padgett, age 60, is a boarder in the household of Bedford Rolen (actually Benjamin F Rowland, ref 1900). Bedford's wife is Phillip's daughter Maggie.

I notice that in this census Jane still has her maiden name. This seems confirms earlier indications that Jane Padgett never married. However, she is listed as widowed. So the mystery of her husband is not yet solved.

This leaves a discrepancy of the birth date. The 1900 census records birth dates, by month and year. Jane McSwain is reported as born in January 1849, consistent with the report in 1900 of her age as 51. This is 4-5 years off from the birth year of 1854, estimated from age 26 in the 1880 census.

This census says "Bear" and Sarah L have been married 6 years. We may conclude that M A (whose names I have not yet figured out) died before 1894. There are two children in the household named Woods, born in Mississippi. Although this census reports these are daughter and son of Burl ("Bear"), they are his step-children. They are 14 and 8 years old, and thus born before this marriage. We may also then conclude that Sarah was previously married to a man named Woods. We also note that Sarah has lost 4 of her 8 children.

There are two new children here, Bryan J and Loula, that were born to Sarah after her marriage to Burl.

- x. **Levina Padgett**^[91, 172] was born in 1855 in North Carolina^[91, 172]. She married Julius Logan McSwain about 1875 in Arkansas County, Arkansas^[94, 96]. She died on Unknown.

Notes for Levina Padgett:

General Notes:

Julius' wife is listed in the 1880 census as Viney. This is a nickname for Levina (Lavina) or Lavinia. The surrounding circumstances and ages lead to the impression that Julius' wife Viney is Levina Padgett, daughter of Wiley and Lavinia (Levina, Lavina) Padgett. Several members of the Padgett and McSwain families married each other over two generations. Lavinia herself is a McSwain. Another daughter of Wiley and Lavinia, Martha Elizabeth, married a brother of Julius, Phillip K.

It appears from similar extensive circumstantial evidence, that their sister Harriet L also married one of the McSwain brothers, George B. They are of the ages to match the later reports for their spouses, and the two families were living close together in North Carolina, moved to Tennessee together, although living a few counties apart in the 1870 census, and then settled in the same location in Arkansas.

General Notes:

There is some discrepancy between sources on whether William David and his brother David were born in Orange County, North Carolina or in Virginia. Some sources express uncertainty between these two locations for the sister Priscilla, which some sources do not list in the genealogy. Due to

the line of migration from Pennsylvania to North Carolina, there is reason to believe that the older son David was born in Virginia.

Cleveland County was created out of Rutherford and a bit of neighbouring areas in 1841. Thus some sources might differ or overlap in the use of the names. I have noticed that some sources even place events in "Cleveland, Rutherford." Some sources are also unclear as to whether they intend a city (or township or location) name or a county name.

Some sources refer to William and his father as William I and William II. But they are not commonly referred to as William (David) Sr and Jr. Some sources just give the same full name for both, but without any sequential designations.

Then one source refers to William II and his son as William Sr and William Jr. But I do not find sources that clearly inform us that the third William's name was William David, which you would expect if he is a Junior to his father who was William David II.

The will of William lists all his children [See below]. Note that the second child is referred to as Polly, yet the name in other sources is either Mary or Mary Margaret. I find Polly is a common nickname for women named Mary in the 1800s. There are several McSwain children named Mary but called Polly. Some sources seems to indicate that a child is named Mary Polly. The same child will be listed in one census as Mary and the next census as Polly.

Sarah is listed in the will as Sally, a common nickname for Sarah. The witness Hugh Kerr is a great great grandson of William David.

One source had two separate children, Mary and Margaret. The estimated date of birth of Margaret was 1792. But the exact date of birth in that source for the next child, William, was 22 Sep 1792. This means no other child could have been born to that family in 1792. That date is also reported for William by other sources.

For a long time I found no other sources with the name Mary Margaret, or a separate Margaret. It appeared best to follow this World Family Tree source in naming this child Mary Margaret. In July 2007 I found one site that gave Margaret as the nickname of this Mary, with the same birth date, but different county information (Orange instead of Rutherford), but a different approximate death date with the same location:

This may need to be reconsidered, since I have discovered that the Hamrick family data has a set of children with birth dates beginning after the date of death of Mary McSwain, wife of Elijah Hamrick. According to the list of children, Mary had 10 children before she died in 1823.

They list Margaret, her sister as the second wife of Elijah, who had 7 more children after that. 17 children would be a lot of children for one woman to have. And the death year of 1823 matches the death date I have from other sources for Mary Margaret: 23 Feb 1823.

It is noted that with the dates from initial sources, Susannah was born in 1818, which would mean that her mother was over 50 years old when she was born. The dates come from otherwise solid family sources. I later found another very high-quality source, a compilation of several McSwain family researchers, which does not have this person. I have not been able to identify here with a next-generation or younger same-generation set of parents. One source reported a birth year of 1788, which seemed too early.

In July 2007, I found a genealogy that had an earlier birthdate of 1793 instead of 1813. This is more reasonable and in line with the birth dates of the other children of this family. However, the birth place reported by that source is Orange County, sources report Rutherford County, and the new source reported the other children as born in Rutherford County. That would put Susannah as the odd one out with three after her born in Rutherford again. So I am reporting Rutherford County as the place, but the date as About 1793.

A birth year figured from the death date of 27 September 1867, yields a birth year of 1804. But this cannot be, since the well-substantiated birth date of his son Louis Hobson is 3 October 1814. The age in the grave marker cannot be right, since the 1860 census gives his age as 66! Based on this census age, if he died in 1867, he should have been 73, not 63!

A source in One World Tree gives a date of 28 August 1794. This is a reasonable date, which I am following. This matches the birth year yielded by the August 1860 census age of 66. This is also close to the September 1850 census when he is age 55, yielding a birth year of 1795. If he died in 1867, he would have been 77 at his death, not 63.

Similar problem occur with the reported birth dates and ages for Susannah. The 1850-60 censuses are close and provide a reasonable date of birth, also matching some genealogy sources.

Ages are a problem with discrepancies in censuses. Paul Sarrett estimates year of birth based on 1800 and 1810 census. He gives 1793 as year of birth, based on age 7 in 1800 census and age 17 in 1810 census. Other sources give 1792, a common figure. The burial information gives 1806 as the birth year, with the exact date of 28 Feb 1806.

But the 1850 census leads to a birth year of 1806, based on his reported age of 44! This is a difference of 13 years! This is the date of birth reported by the Hamrick genealogy and others. His wife Judith (Hamrick) is reported to be 41 in 1850, which yields a birth year of 1809. This actually matches the other information on her.

Polly, David, George and Elijah are out on their own now. Elijah and his wife Susanna (Hamrick) are living next door in house #956. A few houses down from William we find David and his wife Delphia (listed in this census as Delfa) with their daughter Judith V, age 1.

Some genealogies have not been careful or consistent about the place names for birth and death. Very few comment to explain why they have the data they do, or indicate they are aware there is any discrepancy or uncertainty to deal with.

In the eastern states, county names can be a problem, since colonial colonies were divided up as populations and organization grew. Tryon County originally was about the western half of North Carolina. This was divided up into Rutherford and other divisions in 1779. The name Cleveland County comes into being in 1841 when Rutherford was divided, and boundaries were reconfigured. I have tried to use the name current at the time, but I have probably not been consistent. I have had to follow secondary sources for many locales.

Judith Hamrick daughter of Elijah Matterson Hamrick and Mary Margaret McSwain^[216, 217, 221, 256, 257] was born on 01 Feb 1809 in Rutherford County, North Carolina^[217, 256, 258, 259, 260]. She died on 30 Nov 1894 in Cleveland County, North Carolina^[259, 261].

For a long time I had no death information, but in September found further details in recent new postings of sources on Acnstry.com. Ensley's death date had been reported in the Hamrick genealogy, but there was no location or explanation. The Civil War records tell us he died of war wounds in Richmond, Virginia.

Two different reports of Ensley's service in the Army of the Confederate States of America provide some helpful details I have not found in any family genealogy sources. These, along with the 1860 census, which I found the same day as the Civil War records, indicates that the proper form of his name was likely Ensley. His name was recorded as Ainsley in the 1850 census, which was the only public record I initially could find for this person.

We also learn from this that he is crippled. I have found no further details to explain what this means, or whether this is the result of an accident or if he was crippled from birth.

For a long time I could find no information indicating that Sarah H McSwain ever married. Finally in March 2008, I found one family genealogy, by Shane Hamrick, that reported the spouse of Susannah H McSwain. She married James Louis Hamrick in 1872. James was born in 1852 and died in 1907, according to Shane.

In the 1850 census she is listed as 2 years old. But family genealogies report her birth date as 24 December 1846. This would mean that in August 1850, she would have been 3 and almost 4.

15. **Mary Nancy Bridges** daughter of James Bridges and Elizabeth Hamrick was born in 1789. She died on Unknown.

General Notes:

The children of Nancy's parents are difficult to work out. Different family sources have different information. Some have two daughters named Nancy, one born in 1768 and another in 1789, which would be this one. Some information indicates that this second Nancy's name was Mary Nancy. However, one source has this Nancy and a sibling Mary with separate birth information and different husbands. Too many details are missing to be certain.

A genealogy of Descendants of William Bridges reports three separate sisters, with some information but not all the facts we would like. Nancy Bridges b 1768 is shown as the first child of James Bridges and Rebecca Hamrick, while Nancy Bridges born 1789 is the 6th child. This James Bridges is reported as the son of William Bridges, born about 1726 in Prince William County, Virginia. This James is thought to be the 5th son of William.

The Hamrick family data pages, however, reports the wife of this James Bridges to be Elizabeth Hamrick, which appears to be a different person, rather than the same Rebecca with a different or additional name. The Bridges genealogy does indicate some uncertainty as to whether the name of James' wife was Rebecca Hamrick.

The William Bridges genealogy reports that Nancy Bridges born in 1768 married Price Hamrick. The Bridges genealogy reports that the second Nancy born 1789 married Benjamin Hughes. Another source indicates she was Ben's second wife. The Hamrick information does not have a separate Nancy born 1789, but appears to show this birth date on another entry for Nancy who married Price Hamrick. The death date in both cases is 1830, the date given in the Bridges genealogy for the first Nancy born 1768.

The Bridges genealogy reports the third sister to be named Mary and married to William McSwain. This matches earlier information I had for Mary Nancy Bridges married to William McSwain. The Bridges genealogy has separate birth and death dates for their second Nancy and their Mary: Nancy

born in 1789 and died 1875 and Mary born in 1892. This source has no death date for Mary.

If this is based on firm information, this indicates that earlier information giving the name of William McSwain's wife Mary Nancy should be modified to Mary. I have not found full information on all these people. Unfortunately, too many posted sources do not tell how they arrived at what they post. Thus I have not been able to definitely determine which source is reliable.

One of their sisters Salena W (also known as Frances or Frankie) Bridges married another McSwain named Thomas. This matches William's brother. Both were sons of William David McSwain and Judith Moore.

William McSwain and Mary Nancy Bridges were married on 16 Apr 1811. They had the following children:

In 1850, Richard and his wife Mary Polly Weathers are living 2 doors down from Mary's sister Catherine (spelled Catharine here) Weathers and her husband George McSwain. Richard and Mary Polly's son John Franklin, age 9 in 1850, moves later to Arkansas, and is the first of this McSwain clan to arrive in Ethel, Prairie Township of Arkansas County.

John Franklin and his wife Mary are accompanied by George and Catherine's son Francis to Arkansas, where they were registered as two households next door to each other in the 1870 census. Before the move, George had died, and Catherine and the rest of the family moved west, but stayed for a while in Jefferson County, Tennessee, where we find them reported in the 1870- census. Catherine and the rest of her family arrive in Prairie Township about 1875-76.

(estimated) birth date, usually 1721, whereas a common estimated date for William David (or David) is 1725.

Douglas McSwain in his McSwain Genealogy (<http://familytreemaker.genealogy.com/users/m/c/s/Doug-Mcswain/WEBSITE-0001/UHP-0001.html>) seems to indicate that his entry for David is the same as the other entry I have here from various other sources as William David.

Most sources list the place of birth for this William David McSwain as "On the open sea, Isle of Skye, Scotland). It is not clear from this if they mean he was born on a ship that happened to be out at seas at that time, from its base in Skye, or if they mean on a ship that had set sail for America from Skye. Likely the latter. But then it is not logical to include Isle of Skye in the location for place of birth!

It appears to me that William David (William I, or William David Sr) was born on the ship taking his parents to North America. Various events find them in Pennsylvania, Virginia, then North Carolina. Sources differ on the birthplaces of some children.

This William McSwain appears to be the one whose military gravestone is found in the McSwain Cemetery in Cleveland (Then Rutherford) County, North Carolina. This has no dates but indicates he was a member of Brevard's Company #10 in the Revolutionary War.

Due to the line of migration from Pennsylvania to North Carolina, there is reason to believe that the older son David was born in Virginia.

Paul Sarrett has earlier dates than some sources on certain siblings in this generation. Paul reports David as the first child, born in 1750, while others lack a date. The Lawson genealogy also follows the date of 1750 for David. Paul has a date of birth for Priscilla in 1756, while others have 1768. Some sources have dates on only some. Most have no

date on the marriage, so I have used Paul's early birth date for David and his estimated marriage date based on that, "Before 1750."

There is some confusion about the spouse of this David McSwain. Some genealogies have assigned the wife of this David's son with Susannah Hamrick, the wife of his son. A descendant Douglas details the family and explains this historical anomaly. Douglas has done very good critical work in reconstructing this family. I am including some of the good commentary from his website, which you should visit for high-quality information on the early American McSwains in the line I detail in this genealogy.

He comments on the burial place and replacement headstone on David's grave in the McSwain Cemetery in Cleveland County, north Carolina:

"This stone was erected in the 1930's by the DAR. It is located at the McSwain Family Cemetery in Cleveland County, NC believed to be the burial site of David McSwain." Douglas indicates the DAR put the wrong wife's name on here, putting Susannah Hamrick, the wife of David's son, William David. This error has been picked up by some other genealogies.

I have also found that some genealogies have confused (mixed) two different McSwain lines. A location of a family in Baltimore, Maryland, who later also migrated into North Carolina, are inserted in this or the next generation, showing the wrong parents for William McSwain who married Judith a Moore. My wife's ancestor George was one of William's and Judith's sons. The David shown here is the correct ancestor of William, husband of Judith Moore and father of George McSwain who married Catherine Weathers, who later moved to Arkansas with her sons, after the death of George.

Here is Douglas' summary statement of the family's progress from Pennsylvania to North Carolina:

"My MCSWAIN branch is found almost exclusively in what is today southern Cleveland County, NC. Cleveland County was formed in 1841 when the N C Legislature created it from Rutherford County. Rutherford County came into existence in 1779 during the American Revolution. Prior to 1779, Rutherford County was part of Anson and Old Tryon Counties. The earliest McSwain moved to this area between 1760 and 1770 when it was still a colony of the Crown and very much a frontier.

Most researchers claim the Isle of Skye, Scotland as the ancestral home of the McSwains. Many feel the McSwains are a branch of the MacQueen clan. The spelling of McSwain sometimes appears as MacSwain, McSween, McSwaine, or other variations, depending on how the census enumerator heard it pronounced. It is doubtful that many of the early settlers in this area were literate or even able to write their names.

David McSwain, the patriarch, is thought to have arrived in Philadelphia with his family in 1731 probably as an indentured servant. This was the most common way an immigrant earned his passage to the New World. He would have been required to work seven to ten years before being released from his indenture. During this time he would have been seeking land of his own so that he too could prosper.

But eastern Pennsylvania was getting crowded and as a result land was becoming expensive. Many immigrants chose to leave for the frontier of western Virginia, North and South Carolina, and Georgia. It appears that David and some of his family began the trek south between 1750 and 1760. By this time all of his known children were adults. They were the ones most likely to feel the pressure to go. David would follow them because in those times, family was your only support in old age and he would not wish to be left behind.

The family's route south would take them on the Great Philadelphia Wagon Road from east-central Pennsylvania through western Maryland into the Shenandoah Valley of western Virginia. This would not be a trip with a beginning and a quick end but more of a quest for a better way of life. They would travel and settle in an area for a period of perhaps two to three years. Some of David's children and grandchildren may have married and stayed as the family group moved on.

The Great Philadelphia Wagon Road south continued from Virginia into the northern piedmont of North Carolina. Their route would have gone past present day Winston-Salem and Salisbury into the Yadkin River Valley. The McSwains would have followed the rise of the Appalachian mountains to the west into what would become Cleveland County, NC. Some of the family found a home in the rolling hills along the Broad River. Others moved on into South Carolina and northern Georgia while David, the patriarch, most likely in his sixties and weary, stays with his son, David."
